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Destination Ibiza

Calum Macleod of Calum Yacht Services looks at why Ibiza is becoming the essential destination for super yachts during the busy charter seasons.

Ibiza is ... A place where dreams come true! An enigmatic Mediterranean jewel of an island where Balearic hippies in boho chic stand side by side with the glamorous - bejewelled - bikini clad - international jet-set. An Island whose deliciously hedonistic nightlife is balanced out by an ever increasing number of yoga retreats and health food restaurants. The sun kissed beaches, aquamarine sea and

pine forested interior continue to draw a vast number of visitors back year upon year. The UNESCO world heritage Dalt Vila has become an instantly recognized silhouette worldwide. Located 79km off the coast of Valencia, it is the third largest of the Balearic islands and along with neighbouring Formentera and S'espalmador makes up the Pitiusas or Pine Islands. These waters are home to the unique UNESCO protected Posidonia grass prairies.



Heritage

Ibiza's history stretches back 1000's of years and the 1999 inclusion into the UNESCO categories for Biodiversity and Culture have helped promote an Ibiza to a wider audience than the ones seeking only sun, sea and parties. Dalt Vila is a veritable memorial to history, it's many strata of earth contain remnants of all the cultures that have inhabited the island, from the very first settlers in the bay of the city of Ibiza, to the Phoenicians, Carthaginians, Romans and Moors, up to the Christian conquest led by the King of Aragón in the 13th century. Other sites listed are the underwater posidonia meadows, which are the source of the rich marine biodiversity and crystal clear waters of the Pitiusas Islands. The Phoenician settlement of Sa Caleta and the Punic necropolis Puig des Molins, contain the vestiges of the first settlements on the islands.

Night Life

Ibiza boasts the world's best nightclub venues, hosting internationally renowned DJs whose careers are built on the reputation of their events here. The 'big four' original clubs - Pacha, Amnesia, Privilege and this coming season introducing "Hi" the futuristic night club, will hold court amongst the dedicated clubbers. DC10, Ushuaïa continue to claim a very big following. This year looks set to be huge; our top tips for an amazing night out are ... Pacha - Saturday nights are Pure Pacha & Paris by night, hosted by the world famous French Dj, Bob Sinclar. This weekly party will come with an array of fantastic artists. Amnesia, will be hosting some of the world's best and cutting edge electronic DJ's and producers, which have been going for over 15 successful years at the venue. Over at Ushuaïa, you will be treated to the talents of David Guetta and Axwell & Ingrosso. See you on the dance floor!





Gourmet

In recent years Ibiza has quietly become a real foodie island, the amount of new restaurants serving high quality food, using local ingredients prepared by renowned chefs, is a delight for all who visit. At Heart, Cirque de Soleil provide entertaining performance art coupled with the Adria brother's gastronomic excellence, art-meets-food-meets-music, promises an inspiring dining experience. Rumour has it Hard Rock Hotels Sublimotion restaurant is the most expensive dining experience available in Ibiza at €1500 per person. This offers an original and exclusive event for the lucky few who can manage to get a table.

Beaches & Deep Water Anchorages

Ibiza and Formentera's beautiful jagged coastline offer a multitude of beaches and coves to explore. There are the lively: Cala Jondal home to Blue Marlin, Ibiza's infamous beach club or Café Del Mar that made the Ibiza sunset the stuff of legend with the release of their ever popular CD collections. The peaceful Cala Tarida, where The Cotton Beach Club features regular flamenco performances or Cala Charraca, a remote forested cliff top bay. The magical: Isla Vedranell (or Es Vedra to the locals) is said to be a sister to the magnetic Bermuda triangle and is home to dolphins and turtles that constantly frequent the site. And last but not least Formentera, only 11km from Ibiza and features an incredible array of seafood restaurants. Es Palmador whose rich muddy sediment is said to have healing properties.



Scuba Diving

With over 200 kilometres of spectacular coastline and crystal blue water, it makes Ibiza a popular resort for both amateur and professional diving, all year round. The various dive sites range from cave dives to wreck dives; both guaranteeing sublime marine life and varied rock formations.

Paddle Surf

Paddle Surf is one of the relaxed ways that enables you to explore Ibiza's stunning coastline and tranquil bays at your leisure. For the more adventurous and speed orientated you can extend your paddle boarding experience with the latest jet propulsion systems just hitting the market, however please take note this is not to be used in the marine national park. Don't forget your sun cream!



Fine Dining

Fine dining in Ibiza rivals many other European hotspots- just what you expect from a delicious dining experience. Below we have highlighted for you some of the best Restaurants to dine in.

Amante – Beautiful cliff top dining. Italian-influenced Mediterranean cuisine. For an extra special experience, book the Amante table – a private dining space in a Balinese hut on the Cliffside complete with a bespoke menu and personal waiter.

KM5 – Beautiful 500-year old finca (farm house) with an open air garden filled with Moroccan Haimas. Grilled meats are the big stars on Km5’s menu, leaders in Nikkei cuisine, a fusion of Japanese and Peruvian cuisine. VIP lounge and dancing after dinner.

The View, 7 Pines Resort - simple yet exciting European gastronomy using Korean cooking techniques. The restaurant’s Chef’s Table - set around an open kitchen will have its own special menu and allow close interaction with the chef. Extensive selection of fine wines.

Nobu Hotel Ibiza Bay - 4 restaurants and bars serving food for all tastes. Café Celicioso offers gluten-free dishes and Nobu Japanese Restaurant specializes in Japanese fusion cuisine. Guests can enjoy Chiringuito’s beachfront restaurant serving fresh seafood.

Atzaro Beach Restaurant – Enjoy Ibicencan style rice and fresh fish dishes, cocktails, massage and live music, overlooking Tagomago island at Playa de Cala Nova.

Destino – the gastro bar offers tropical zesty flavours from central America, great cocktails, healthy juices and their iconic sushi rolls. Enjoy poolside events from the sunbeds and hammocks, live DJs or even some cheeky drinks in the jacuzzi.



Exceptional Dining

Above and beyond the Ibiza fine dining experience, there are three additional restaurants in Ibiza that deserve a special mention. These are places where the cuisine is just one part of the experience, and where special care and dedication has been taken to ensure a night to remember. These are experiences not available anywhere else in the world.

Sublimotion – 2014 saw the launch of Sublimotion, a concept restaurant like no other. Sublimotion is the brainchild of famed chef Paco Roncero, holder of two Michelin Stars. The space was two years in the making and incorporated consultants from many different fields – from set designers to choreographers, screenwriters, engineers and illusionists; all brought together to ensure this is a restaurant beyond compare. The restaurant seats only 12 guests around one large table and the dining experience is as much a show as a dinner. Your night begins when you are picked up at a secret-only-revealed-on-the-day location – and you enter a magical world designed to take you on a gastronomic journey that reaches all the senses via the sophisticated audio visual system, a room where the temperature changes with each course and a sublime 21-course tasting menu is so delicious the 3-hour dinner passes quickly. The food is described as Spanish avant-garde cuisine, which means surprises-a-plenty, think edible art.

Heart – Opened just a couple of years ago and has quickly become the place to go for the ‘In-crowd’, situated next to the casino opposite Marina Ibiza. This stunning venue is owned by Guy Laliberte, who was the creator and owner of the world-famous Cirque du Soleil. The Restaurant, which is headed up by celebrated Master chefs, Ferran and Albert Adria of El Bulli, serve outstanding gastronomic fine dining. After midnight, the venue transforms seamlessly into a nightclub, with some great theatrical shows along the way. A must see during your stay in Ibiza!

Lio – A Burlesque - cabaret like no other. This fantastic restaurant and cabaret venue features the best view of the old town and a waiting list to prove how popular it is. Your fine dining experience is accompanied by show stopping performances - every night is cabaret night and after the show, DJs take centre stage until the wee hours of the morning. Thursday’s Be Crazy party with Jean Claude Ades is a weekly highlight.

La Imprenta – Ibiza’s brand new creative fine dining venue. Elegant & glamorous with a varied Mediterranean menu and fabulous cocktails. This innovative, haute cuisine restaurant brings a touch of Parisian chic to the port of Ibiza and is the only restaurant in town offering a fantastic cabaret show, every night.



Rustic Beach Dining

Lunch in Ibiza means only one thing FISH! Leaving the beach clubs behind and searching out the rustic Spanish style fish restaurants is an absolute must. Below is a selection of some of the best on offer.

El Bigote – This delightful rustic shack perches perilously on the side of the rocks at Cala Mastella. There is no menu here, they serve the house speciality only – Bullit de Peixyarroz al banda; fresh fish with rice boiled in a fish broth, cooked in front of you over an open fire.

Es Xarcu – This wonderful beach shack style restaurant serves fresh selection of fish and seafood daily with oysters and lobsters straight from the vivero/tank. Situated at the foot of an enormous cliff makes for an adventurous drive down & an incredible approach from the sea.

Sa Caleta – Wonderful cliff top lunch spot. The house speciality has to be the oven cooked John Dory with potatoes and peppers, or the end of meal Café Caleta; flaming coffee with alcohol served expertly in an earthen ware pot.

Es Torrent– This is five-star dining with your feet in the sand! Owner XicuSala opened his shack 10 years ago and has created one of the islands finest seafood dining experiences. The Sea cucumbers and sautéed clams are heavenly!

Es Boldado– Boasting one of the finest views on all of Ibiza, this hill side restaurant serves wonderful paella and fish dishes on the busy little beach of Cala D’hort overlooking the immense Es Vedra island rock. A must!

Malibu –A popular spot on the lovely Las Salinas beach, surrounded by sand dunes and pine trees, which offers traditional Mediterranean cuisine, cocktails and live DJs.



Beach Clubs

Ibiza is home to some of the biggest and best beach club venues, many of these are highlights to most people's holiday. With day time partying becoming more and more popular. What's not to like, dancing to your favourite DJ in the sun, on the beach with a cocktail and some friends?

Cotton Beach Club – Relax for the day at Cala Tarida. The internationally themed terrace restaurant is fantastic, the new high-end Asiatic themed rooftop terrace is divine and there are private cabins and showers available on the beach below.

Experimental Beach – Right in the heart of Ses Salines, this is the perfect sunset destination, with breath taking views across to Es Vedra. Enjoy authentic, French-inspired food, eclectic, creative cocktails and live music on Thursday evenings.

El Chiringuito – Es Cavallet's beautiful laidback beach club serves delicious lunch, famous for their Sunday brunch menu. Eat alongside chilled beats from Ibiza's favourite resident DJs Mr Doris and Andy Baxter.

Nikki Beach – World famous beach club, contemporary cuisine and modern music. Jet-Set Saturdays is the signature party night whilst the Thursday beach BBQ is a more laid back affair and Sunday's Champagne Brunch is a favourite.

Ocean Beach – Changing the face of San Antonio! A poolside party venue with sunset views. The champagne fuelled Ibiza Spray and Hed Kandi cater to a young English party crowd

Nassau Beach Club- The Asiatic kitchen at Nassau serves cutting edge molecular gastronomy at their all-new Tepayaki corner, with an elegant beachfront setting at Playa d'en Bossa.

Tanit Beach Ibiza – Mediterranean cuisine, elegantly chilled music, refined decor, excellent service & exquisite food overlooking the famous Playa d'en Bossa.

Amante – Seafood, Mediterranean, European and Spanish cuisine overlooking an idyllic rocky cove at Cala Llonga. Open 11a.m. 'til 2a.m.

Blue Marlin- sophisticated and stylish restaurant, beach and terrace contemporary dining with live evening sessions from Pete Tong, Tommy Vee and Mauro Ferrucci.

Jockey Club – A fresh and varied Mediterranean menu and cocktails are available, as well as comfy beach beds, cocktails, live DJs and a funky shop for souvenirs. Open daily 9a.m. 'til 9p.m.

Cala Bassa Beach Club – You will be spoiled for dining choice – the main restaurant serves gastronomic cuisine, Chiringo Restaurant serves Mediterranean and local dishes, or check out their Sushi, Snack and Gourmet corners. Sunbeds, masseuses and souvenirs make it a great all day venue to relax at.

Hippie Markets

Ibiza hippy markets are a fantastic shopping experience and a great excuse to get away from the hustle and bustle of the beach. Tie it in with a lovely laidback lunch and it's a wonderful day or evening out.

La Dalias - The original island hippy hangout which has captivated visitor's imagination for over 30 years! Best for clothes, leather, jewellery, incense and dream catchers. Also host to a great healthy juice stall, a tapas bar and world food market.

Open every Saturday from 10.00 – 20.00 and Monday from 19.00 - 01.00

Once Upon a Time in Ibiza - A whimsical selection of stalls. Best for creations from new designers, vintage sunglasses and handmade jewellery. Boutique Hostal Salinas also has a bar and restaurant open all day. Fortnightly on Saturdays at Boutique Hostal Salinas from 14.00

San Jordi - A cross between a market and car boot sale. Best for vintage glass and crockery, second hand clothes stalls, original Ibiza art and the kitchen sink! There is an onsite café great for 'bocadillos de jamon' and rich Spanish coffee.
Open every Saturday 08.00 - 14.30

Es Cana - Another old favourite and one of the largest markets, based at Punta Arabi on the island's east coast. The Wednesday edition of the hippy market includes onsite health food stalls and bar. Open every Wednesday from 10.00 - late

San Miguel Artisan Market - Wonderful street market in the picturesque village of San Miguel. Best for handmade soap, jewellery is locally made, traditional Ibicenco crocheted linens. Look out for the local Ibiza dance shows.
Open every Thursday from 18.00 – 21.00

San Juan Village Market - Held in the quaint village plaza of San Juan. Best for organic local food and produce plus handmade hippy attire.
Open every Sunday 18.00 – 23.00

A trip across to Ibiza's sister island Formentera is a must for every island visitor. CYS recommends the following hotels and restaurants.

Juan y Andrea – Formentera's most famous fish restaurant, open since 1972 and serving up delicious dishes to the many glamorous boats that arrive on their shore daily. It started with the love story of owners Juan and Andrea and continues to be run by their three sons. Tender service from boat to restaurant

Es Moli de Sal - In a tastefully renovated mill, Es Molí de Sal boasts a lovely terrace and magnificent sea views. It serves some of Formentera's finest seafood and salads, plus a few meat and pasta dishes. Try one of the rice dishes (such as arroz negro) or the house speciality, caldereta de llagosta (lobster stew), home-made icecream rounds off the dining experience. Tender service available.

Beso Beach – A fabulous beachside restaurant oozing boho chic, where the ambience, sandy floor and palm canopy décor offers a fabulous and lively day out. Fantastic seafood served with panache, the fresh seafood is cooked on a huge grill in the restaurant, and once lunch is cleared away the superb mojitos fuel impromptu early evening beach parties. Tender service available.

Gecko Beach Club – Boutique hotel with a fantastic restaurant, serving up food inspired by a combination of cultures around the world. No tender service, however they can collect you by car.

South Beach Club – A 'get away from it all' beach club with sun loungers on the beach, raffia sun shades and great Mediterranean fusion restaurant. No tender service.

Can Dani – Boasting the Pitiuses only Michelin star, this great value hidden gem is not quite on everyone's radar yet. Wonderful seafood and meat dishes are served in the beautiful peaceful garden restaurant - an oasis of calm and Mediterranean charm. First timers should definitely try the 'Menu Degustacion'.

Big Store – A cool hippy hangout in the heart of the islands capital Sant Francesc. Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. The star of the show are the breakfasts, good value and delicious, flaky croissants plus healthy options and freshly squeezed juices. Also great for après beach cocktails.

Blue Bar – A bright blue beach shack with a quirky space-age theme has been serving up Spanish/ Italian dishes on Playa Mitjorn. Blue Bar attracts a local crowd drawn in by economical food and fantastic music selection. Arrive in time for sunset and enjoy delicious cocktails to a smooth soundtrack of chillout, reggae and jazz.
